Media Release for March 13-14, 2019	

On March 13th, 2019, West Nipissing Police received a call from a female on Nipissing Street indicating that her ex-boyfriend had entered her apartment while she was out. The male had been previously charged by police and had conditions not to return to that address. The male suspect left the area prior to police arrival and could not be located. On the morning of March 14th, police received another call from the female stating that the ex-boyfriend had returned and was sleeping inside the apartment. Police arrested the male and he was charged with Break and Enter and Failing to Comply with his conditions. He was held for bail.

On March 13th, 2019, police received a call that an ATV had just been stolen from a residence on Vachon Rd. Police located the ATV travelling on Cache Street in Cache Bay. The ATV was stopped and the male driver was detained. Further investigation revealed, that the suspect had attended an address on Vachon Rd and entered a garage. There, the suspect stole a set of vehicle keys. The suspect was spotted by the home owner and left. The suspect then went next door and entered another garage. He stole the ATV from that residence. Taylor Blais (30yrs) of Sturgeon Falls is charged with Break and Enter x 2, Theft Over \$5,000, and Theft Under \$5,000.

On March 13th, 2019, police attended the LCBO store in Sturgeon Falls regarding a shoplifting complaint. A male attended the store and stole a bottle of Vodka. The male hid the bottle in his clothing and when questioned by store staff, he left the store without paying. Police identified the suspect from store surveillance footage. Police located and arrested Curtis Scriver (21yrs) of Sturgeon Falls. He was charged for Theft Under and kept for bail.

On March 13th, 2019, police arrested a male for Uttering Counterfeit Money. A previous complaint from January 13th, 2019 had been received where the male used a counterfeit \$100 bill. The bill had Chinese markings and was missing the usual security features. Eric Jodouin (32yrs) of Sturgeon Falls was charged and held for bail.
